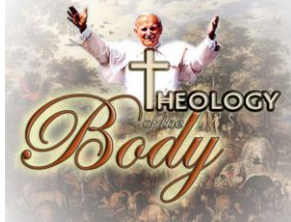

Padre Alberto Gauci O.F.M. belongs to the Franciscan order. Originally he comes from Malta, a small island in Europe, south of Italy. In 1973 he was sent by his superiors to work in the Franciscan missions of Honduras in Central America. The diocese where he works is called Olancho, 256 sq. Kilometers and 500 thousand people. It's one of the most mountainous regions of Honduras. There's only 22 priests. Padre Alberto is in charge of all the social work in the diocese, that is: an orphanage, an old people's home, prison ministry, people sick with aids, a kindergarten, a parish clinic and a nutritional center. He has been happily working in the missions for the last 43 years. Mission Appeal is on the weekend of **July 30 and 31, 2016.**
