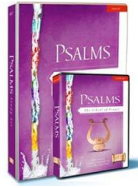

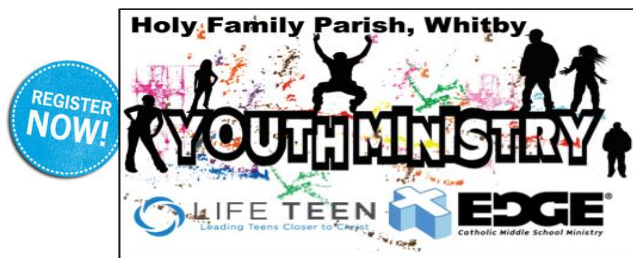
## THE ROSARY APOSTOLATE IN THE SCHOOLS
