As the cold & wintery weather draws near, it is our mission to provide some warmth to our poor & unfortunate homeless who live outside and in the homeless shelters in Durham Region. This year there is a very high demand for Sleeping Bags, Socks, Underwear and Men's & Women's Light but warm Winter Boots (men's sizes 9 to 12) and (women's sizes 7 to 10).

**WE WILL BE LIMITING OUR DRIVE TO SLEEPING BAGS, SOCKS, UNDERWEAR and WINTER BOOTS ONLY.** Though sleeping bags do not provide the same comfort and warmth of a bed, they do provide some warmth & shelter from the frigid temperatures outside. For

those of you who do not have a sleeping bag to donate, but would like to make a monetary donation to cover the cost of a sleeping bag (**which can start as low as \$30.00**) or for any of the items mentioned above are most welcome to do so.

## WHAT IS EUCHARISTIC ADORATION?

At every Mass the priest consecrates simple bread and wine, which, through the power of the Holy Spirit, truly become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. This is the Eucharist, and in the Eucharist is the *Real Presence* of Jesus: **in the Eucharist, Jesus is really present to us just as He was present to His disciples two thousand years ago**, the only difference is the *way* He is present, but the *reality* of His presence is the same. Jesus is really here with us! We are very blessed to have in every Catholic church, at all times, Jesus in the Eucharist reposed in the tabernacle. This makes the church a particularly special and holy place for us to come and pray. **At certain times, the consecrated host is placed on the altar for all in the church to see. This is what we call Eucharistic Adoration.** Here, in a unique way, we are able to adore Jesus truly present with us. Eucharistic Adoration is a time of prayer filled with many graces and blessings.

**Come out and spend some time in Adoration of Jesus in the Eucharist!**

There are many opportunities here at Holy Family:

- † One hour before all weekday Masses
- † Every Friday, from noon until 7:00pm
- † Every First Friday of the month, from noon until midnight
