To set up your free Formed account, visit holyfamilywhitby.formed.org. The registration box for parishioners should appear. Type in our **parish code: 7KKDNY**. Next set up a username and a password. Now you are all set to use all the great programs on FORMED.org anytime simply by logging in. You will be able to see for yourself how enriching these programs are especially when shared in a group setting.

Why not start your own Small Group? It's easy - Just register your group online and we'll walk you through it! All you need is a group of 3 or more people (*friends, family, neighbours or even coworkers*), a place to host with a TV (*most groups alternate homes*), a few snacks & beverages. Then choose one of the six available programs and set a date & time each week or alternate week to meet. Each program consists of a series of videos and a downloadable guide with questions to facilitate a group discussion. PARKING LOT MINISTRY UPDATE

We have started to implement our changes to the parking lot to ensure that we:

1. Create a safe drop-off and pick-up zone for those people who need special accessibility to enter the church.
2. Maximize the flow of cars entering the north Ribblesdale entrance so that they are not backed up onto the street
3. Extend the presence and welcoming of our hospitality ministry to include greeting and assistance in the parking lot

In order to achieve this, we will be re-directing anyone who needs to drop off or pick up parishioners to the front entrance of the church by the ramp. Cars will use the southernmost Ribblesdale entrance in a one-way direction to safely drop off and pick up passengers, then proceed to the parking lot. Cars will no longer be able to stop in front of the side entrance of the church to drop off passengers; this is what causes the back-up onto Ribblesdale which has now become further complicated by the new traffic light. There will be new signage installed, as well as Parking Lot Ministers present and visible to assist with these new safety procedures. Please help us with the successful implementation of this new process by being aware of it, sharing it with others in your family who might be driving to the church, and following the kind directions of our parking lot ministers with patience and understanding. 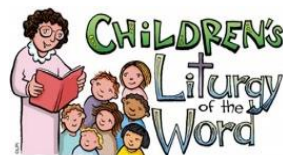
ALPHA RCIA ~ AUG 21
