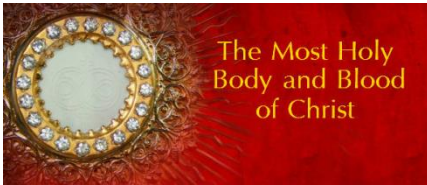

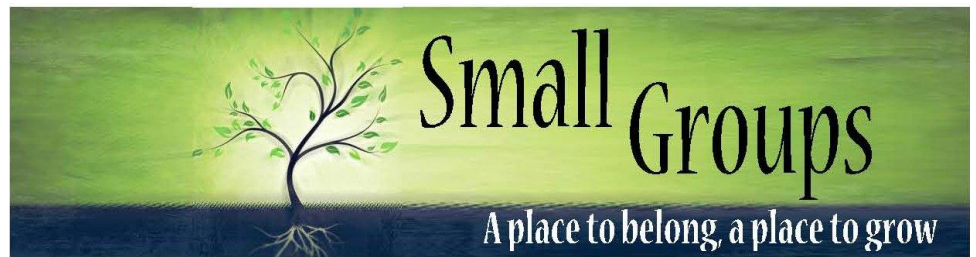

### PARKING MINISTRY

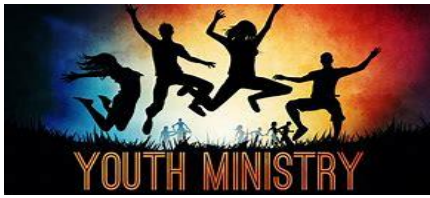
