FAMILY OF FAITH CAMPAIGN

The **Family of Faith** Campaign is rooted in the vision that Cardinal Collins has for the Archdiocese of Toronto. Holy Family Parish has a part to play in the provision for that vision as outlined in the Pastoral Plan of the Archdiocese. The campaign will provide resources to strengthen our **Family of Faith** at Holy Family Parish and throughout the Archdiocese. At Holy Family, having completed the refurbishment of our church building, we will focus on strengthening the ongoing engagement of parishioners and foster our spiritual development.

Both Cardinal Collins and Fr. Laszlo have identified ministry to our children and youth as an essential piece of the **Family of Faith** initiative. Providing engaging and appealing opportunities for children and youth to learn about their faith and grow in a faith filled atmosphere is critical to the future of our church. Throughout the Archdiocese parishes will be provided with resources to hire youth ministers. At Holy Family over 40 of our youth had the opportunity to experience EDGE (Grade 6 to 8) camp this past summer. New funds will allow us to provide more young people with the opportunity to develop their faith in a contemporary fun-filled atmosphere. We will also be able to provide additional funds to children's liturgy, children's choir, Life Teen (Grade 9 to 12) and sacramental preparation.

Your participation in the **Family of Faith** campaign will help build and strengthen our Catholic community.
