YOUTH MINISTRY ADVENT REFLECTION

2ND SUNDAY OF ADVENT IT'S BEEN A LONG TIME COMING.

Prophecy is a tricky thing. Far more than some kind of divinely inspired "fortune telling," the prophets were ordinary people called to share extraordinary things. The prophesy from the first reading demonstrate a promise God makes and communicates through Isaiah that would take a long time to come around, centuries in fact! God may not act on our timeline, but He does act. He may not fulfill all of His promises during your lifetime, but He will fulfill them. That's why St. Paul can write so certainly in the second reading to the Romans. God's holy Word is supposed to bring us encouragement and endurance on this journey we are on. It may take time for prophecies to unfold, but that time allows the rest of us to share the Good News with even more souls, before Christ comes again.
