JOIN US FOR BREAKFAST NEXT SUNDAY!

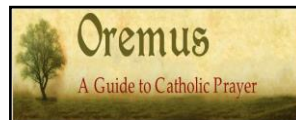

Are you looking to deepen your own prayer life? Join us this Monday for Oremus!

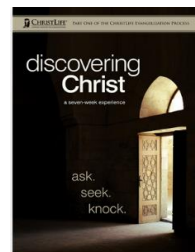
Discover how to overcome your difficulties with prayer.
