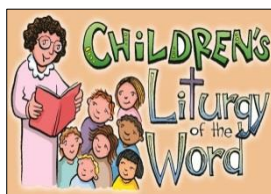
## PARKING LOT MINISTRY UPDATE

Beginning this weekend, we will be implementing changes to our parking lot to ensure that we:

1. Create a safe drop-off and pick-up zone for those people who need special accessibility to enter the church.
2. Maximize the flow of cars entering the north Ribblesdale entrance so that they are not backed up onto the street
3. Extend the presence and welcoming of our hospitality ministry to include greeting and assistance in the parking lot

**In order to achieve this, we will be re-directing anyone who needs to drop off or pick up parishioners to the front entrance of the church by the ramp.** Cars will use the southernmost Ribblesdale entrance in a one-way direction to safely drop off and pick up passengers, then proceed to the parking lot. Cars will no longer be able to stop in front of the side entrance of the church to drop off passengers; this is what causes the back-up onto Ribblesdale which has now become further complicated by the new traffic light. There will be new signage installed, as well as Parking Lot Ministers present and visible to assist with these new safety procedures. Please help us with the successful implementation of this new process by being aware of it, sharing it with others in your family who might be driving to the church, and following the kind directions of our parking lot ministers with patience and understanding. ## **LIFE-SAVING DEFIBRILLATOR NOW ON SITE!**

Thanks to the generous donation of funds from the **Knights of Columbus** and the **CWL**, Holy Family Parish has purchased an AED (Automatic External Defibrillator). The AED will be located on the wall in the lower main stairwell from the parking lot entrance. A number of parishioners have received CPR training and instruction on the use of the AED, however the device is for the use of anyone who encounters an individual in distress. ## **ELEVATOR ACCESSIBILITY**

We want to remind our parishioners who have mobility concerns that the church does have an elevator at the south east entrance at the back of the church which allows access to both the upstairs sanctuary and the downstairs hall.
