



ARE YOU PLANNING TO BE A CATHOLIC SCHOOL TEACHER?

It is critical for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic school board in Ontario, as part of your application for employment there must be a pastoral letter of reference from your pastor. If you are planning to apply to teach in a Catholic school, it is highly recommended you contact the parish months before you apply to have a conversation early in the process and you will avoid disappointment and stress at the time when applications are to be submitted. *Please see the policy below regarding Pastoral letters.*

PASTORAL REFERENCE LETTERS

In order to have Pastoral Letters signed, you must be a registered parishioner, attending Sunday Mass regularly and have volunteered in different parish ministries for at least 4 months. Father László cannot sign a reference form if he does not know the person and has no personal knowledge of the individual's involvement in the parish.
