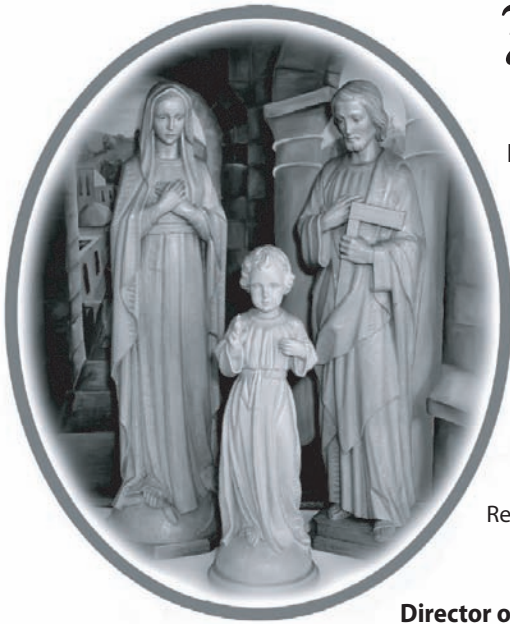

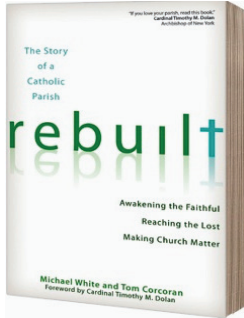
PARENT ALPHA
