PARKING LOT WELCOMING TEAM STARTS TODAY!

This ministry will begin their important service next week, and we would like to clarify the two key purposes, and how you can offer your support:

- SAFETY The safe movement of vehicle and pedestrian traffic as parishioners come and go from Mass, in particular to remind drivers of two main protocols:
 - There is a designated SAFE DROP OFF / PICK UP ZONE at the main doors facing Ribblesdale drive.
 - NO STOPPING is allowed at the parking lot doors, as this causes a back up of vehicles in the drive way, boulevard, & onto the road creating unsafe conditions.
- HOSPITALITY As we move forward with our mission to love God, love others and make disciples, we want to create the most welcoming, invitational environment for whoever comes to our parish, and this now begins in the parking lot!
