Many of us share the celebration of Christmas with family and friends who may come from another city. If you are hosting this year, we invite you to consider the type of invitational environment and welcome you would like them to receive when they come to Holy Family for Mass. Or, if you are not hosting, we ask you to think about how we all contribute to the friendly and caring experience we can extend to the people who come to visit at our church.

Some suggestions - perhaps you can:

- park your vehicle at the plaza or the school to leave room in the parking lot for visitors;
- step in to be a greeter at one of the doors to welcome people arriving for Mass;
- "move up and in" when finding a seat for Mass, move up as far as you can, and into the middle of the pew so that there will be lots of room for others arriving after you (this would help on a regular basis so that people don't feel the need to stand at the back and block the entrances or the welcome desk);
- extend a friendly smile and greeting to others coming in for Mass
- invite people to join you for a coffee in the Gather Café after the weekend Masses
