
DON'T JOURNEY ALONE - JOIN A SMALL GROUP!

➤ **SYNOD means** "journeying together" and it involves listening to the Holy Spirit and to each other in order to discern the path we are called to walk together.

The synod is intended to inspire people to dream about the Church we are called to be, to make people's hope flourish, to stimulate trust, to bind up wounds, to weave new & deeper relationships, to learn from one another, to build bridges, to enlighten minds, warm hearts, and restore strength to our hands for our common mission.

Every Catholic is being asked to prayerfully discern & reflect and share their thoughts & experiences. Over the next few weeks, we will share more information with you on the Synod on Synodality and how we at Holy Family will participate!
