### First Reading Job 38:1-4, 8-11

Much of the book of Job addresses the mystery of suffering and God's role in human affairs. Today we hear part of God's response to Job's questioning with images of the sea and raging waters, representing God's power and omniscience. >What helps remind you that it is God who governs the universe with purpose and fidelity?

### Second Reading 2Cor 5:14-17

Paul encouraged the Corinthians to have the conviction of faith that since Christ died for all, believers should now live for Him. In doing so, we become a "new creation". **>How have you seen this happen in your own life as a believer?** 

### Gospel Reading Mk 4:35-41

Early in their following of Jesus, the disciples' witness of the miracle of Jesus calming the storm at sea led them to ask: "Who then is this whom even the wind & sea obey?" >How would you explain to others who wonder about the divinity of Jesus?
