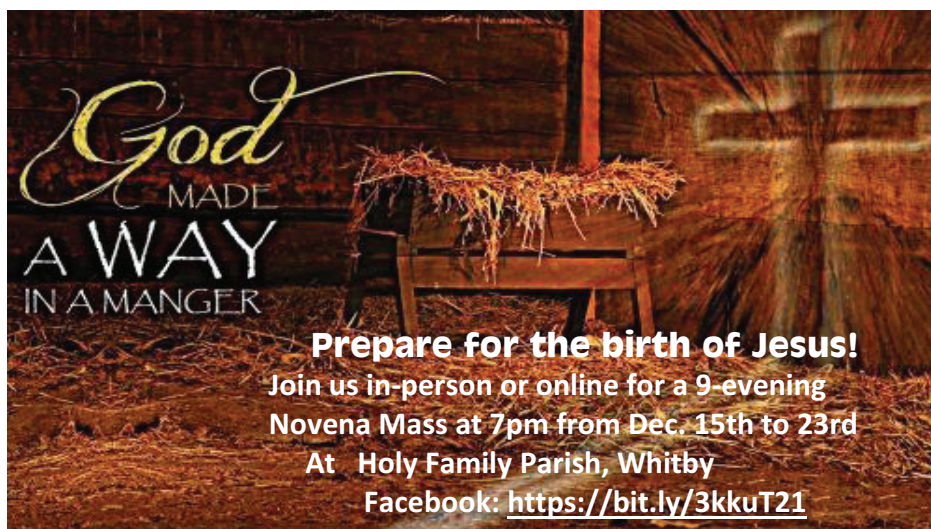
O Come All Ye Faithful!!!
