If either party has gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been contacted."

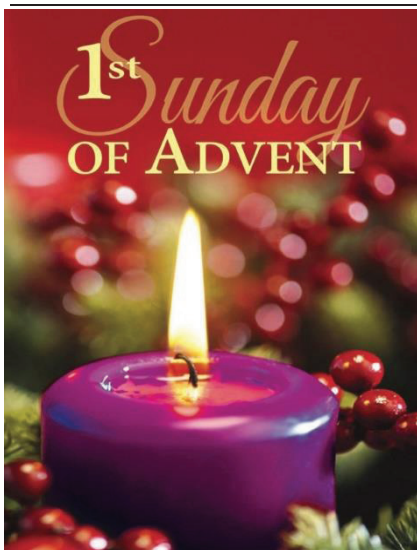

No previous experience is required. FNE provides virtual and in-person training and support sessions. You join an FNE community with leaders who work to support one another and share ideas and experiences.

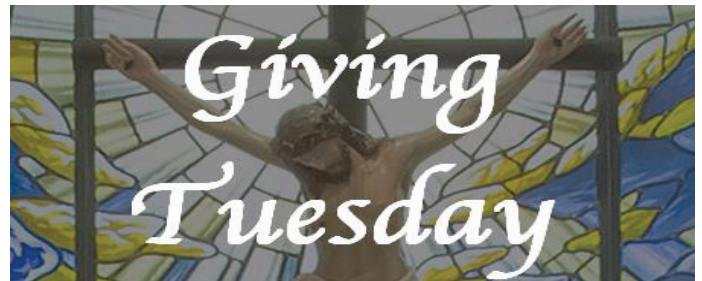
