### Someone's coming to dinner, are you ready?

When we have invited someone to come to our home, there are many things that we do to prepare to welcome them. You know what they are, the cleaning, the cooking, the decorating and gifts if it is a celebration. These are all surface preparations that we go through to make sure in a practical way that things are ready and look nice. What would a more reflective and deeper preparation look like? What if we have not seen the person for a long time? What if it is someone with whom we have had a falling out, or someone we have hurt? Or when we know that there is something we should have done and we didn't. How do we prepare in our thoughts and our hearts for greeting this person?

You know the analogy...the person coming to dinner is Jesus. Yes, to celebrate the birthday of Jesus at Christmas we adorn our houses with decorations, we cook and bake special foods to share, we purchase gifts to give and we plan happy gatherings. We may even go out of our way to contribute our time or money to a charity or acts of kindness. All of this is lovely, it is all a lot of work, yes, but these things are the practical matters just the same.

Jesus was born into the world of a woman, Mary, who gave her total "yes" to God, over 2000 years ago...and as we have waited through Advent, we were reminded that he continues to come into the world, every Christmas, and continually in our life every time we invite him. While Advent was a time of preparation and our opportunity to reflect on who we are and how we live our lives and ask if we are truly followers of Christ, now, all is done, all is ready, and so it is time to ask ourselves if we are prepared to give him our "yes". He appeared among us as an innocent, vulnerable baby, signifying that it is not through power and prestige that we can be his disciples, but that we can be signs of hope and peace for others through the sharing of his overwhelming love for us, imperfect and broken as we are. Every Christmas, we are reminded of his unfailing effort and desire to be present in our lives now, and in the future, as we wait for him to come again.

It is so easy in the busyness of life and this season to rush past any intruding thoughts about our own shortcomings and sinfulness, much less to find time to pause and prayerfully open and prepare our heart. Hopefully, we did some of that, and now on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day, we take a moment in the quiet peacefulness to be truly grateful for the many blessings we have, to pause and seek reconciliation with God and others, and recognize the gifts he has equipped us with, and bring his light into the world through our joyful celebration of his birth. Jesus is coming to dinner, are you ready?

Did you know that almost half of baptized Catholics do not know or don't believe that it is even possible to have a personal relationship with God? This is a total misunderstanding of the Christian faith. How can this be so? Do you believe that God loves you? Do you believe that He would want to be in a relationship with you and that he would leave everything behind to come and find you?

We know Jesus' parable of the lost sheep (*Matt 18: 12-14, Luke 15: 3-7*), when the Good Shepherd who knows and cares for his sheep so deeply that he leaves the 99 to go in search of the one that is lost. This is the metaphor for an upcoming new movement in our parish to further our understanding of being disciples and making disciples.

Can you think of anything that is worth so much more to you than the mere cost of replacing it that you would stop everything, give anything to get it back? This is how God feels about you, and he will search to bring you closer to Him.
