

PASTORAL REFERENCE LETTERS

In order for anyone to have a **Pastoral Letters signed by Father, you must**... be a registered parishioner, attending Sunday Mass regularly, have volunteered in different parish ministries for at least 4 months, be in good canonical standing within the Church - that is not living in common law or married outside the church and financially supporting the work and mission of the Church particularly ShareLife, and your own Parish. All pastoral references are positive but also honest expressions of the Pastor's assessment of the candidate's current level of faith, faith practice and involvement. This assessment is based on personal knowledge and the responses given by the candidate in the interview. Obviously, Fr. László cannot sign a reference form if he does not know the person and has no personal knowledge of the individual's involvement in the parish.
