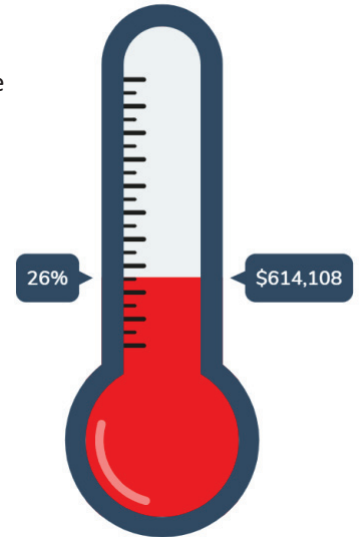
Campaign Update
