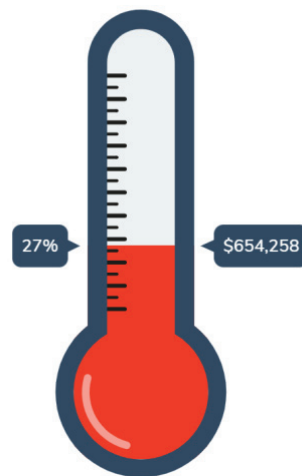
Campaign Update

We are pleased to report that our Ambassador volunteers have made **211 visits** to date with fellow parishioners to go over our campaign materials and answer building plan questions.

So far, we have received pledges totaling **\$654,258**. This represents **27%** of our "Living Our Faith, Building Our Future" campaign goal of \$2.4 million.

Did you know that your contributions to the building fund are not the same thing as a contribution to the capital campaign?

When we formally launched the "Living Our Faith, Building Our Future" campaign in November, the "**Building Fund**" reverted back to "**Restoration and Maintenance**" with all contributions either by Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) or by envelope going toward building maintenance and repair costs such as snow removal, heat, hydro, etc.

While the envelopes in your offertory box still say "Building Fund," **those contributions are no longer being allocated toward the capital campaign** and you may have noticed that the yellow envelopes in the pews now read "Restoration and Maintenance Fund" to reflect this change.
