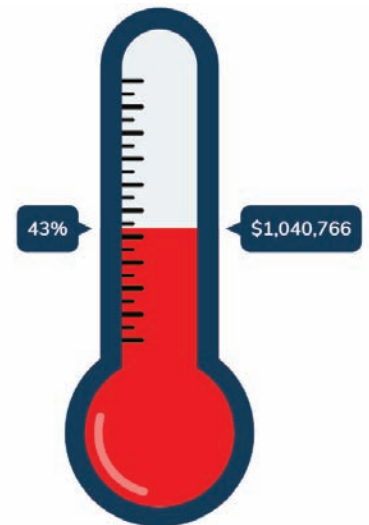
Campaign Update
