THE FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT & NATIVITY OF OUR LORD



A Christmas Reflection by Fr. László

The apostle John contextualizes his account of the words and deeds of his good friend Jesus with an opening prologue that crackles with energy and wonder. Jesus, John wants to tell us, is the very Word of God. He was with God at the creation of the world. He *is* God.

He is life itself, and that life is the light of the world. Then comes verse 5: "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it."

But here's a striking thing in another translation reads differently. It says, "The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it."

The Greek word alternatively rendered "overcome" and "understood" is *katalambanó* – which means to "take hold of" or "grasp." We need more than one English word to try to hint at the full meaning of what John is saying here.

John has seen the Light of the World with his own eyes. He's gone fishing with him. He's eaten with him. He's prayed with him. And he's watched him endure the most horrific death imaginable and then *come back to life*. So John knows that there is no darkness in the universe that can permanently grasp and defeat this light. The darkness cannot *overcome* it.

But John also knows that our human minds, left to their own devices, cannot begin to grasp the love on offer in the astonishing fact of the Incarnation. The darkness cannot *understand* it.

John's prologue culminates with a breathtaking meditation on the lengths to which God has gone to reach us with his illuminating love. "The Word became flesh," he writes, "and made his dwelling among us."

The Mighty God came in the staggeringly vulnerable form of a human baby. The Prince of Peace allowed himself to be birthed into a world of sin and chaos-God made huggable, woundable, kissable, killable.

Only the Light of the World can give us the power to begin to understand what God has offered us in the birth of Jesus. So, this Christmas, let us pray the prayer the apostle Paul offered the Ephesians (3:18): that we, "being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ."

We celebrate Immanuel - God with us - THE Light that overcomes all darkness. As we who daily seek to believe in and follow Him kneel in adoration this day, marveling at God's revelation, let us recommit ourselves to this Jesus, the true Light. May we continually witness to the Light, to this Presence. God's dream for humanity is manifested this day. How blessed (and challenged) we are!

In our celebrations this day let us truly proclaim in word and action that "God is with us"

Today is Christmas! Christ's coming brings the gift of PEACE, Peace comes when enemies reconciled, when family ties that have been broken are mended, when countries can lay down their weapons and sit at table with their enemies, and when we can be reconciled among each other and within ourselves.

The angels greeted Christ's coming with "Glory to God in the highest, and peace to all people on earth." In every part of our world today, people long for peace. Even in our own hearts there lies a searching for peace. These longings for peace remind us that Christ's coming is yet unfulfilled, and Christmas is still a contradiction.

Over two thousand years since his birth, the Christ of Peace, reflected in Luke's gospel, desires to live on in us and in our world.

Today as you read the newspaper or watch the news coverage, pause. Be in touch with the longing for peace within your own heart and within so many places in our world today. Pray that the coming of the Christ of Peace will close the gap between the Sacred and all of creation. This Christmas let us continue the mission of the One who offers Peace.

Heavenly Father, set my preparations for this Christmas on the right foundation: on Your mighty Son, my Saviour. I pray in His holy Name. Amen.
