If either party has gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been contacted."

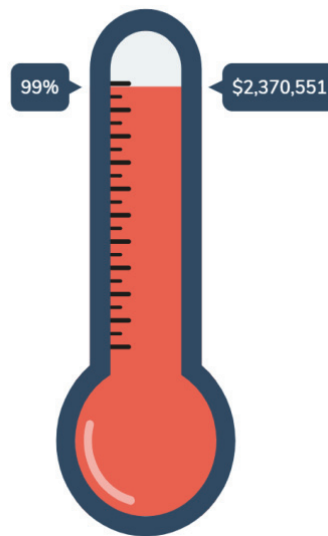

As of December 31, 2023 we have raised \$2,370,551 towards our campaign goal of \$2.4 million from 472 pledges.

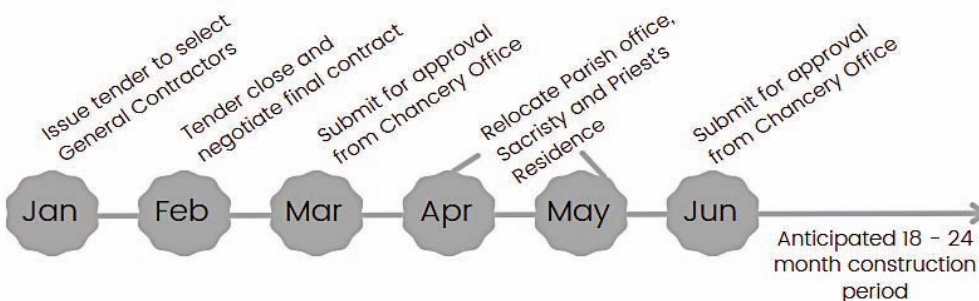
