

If you are planning to enroll your child for one of these sacraments this fall, please ensure that you know where his or her BAPTISMAL CERTIFICATE is as you will need it to register. If your child was baptized in another Christian denomination OR has not been baptized yet, and you wish to have them receive the sacraments, arrangements will need to be made for him or her to be either baptized or 'Received' into the Catholic Church.
