CONTRUCTION UPDATE...

"We are pleased to share that construction began this summer for the new Atrium addition, renovated offices and rectory.

Ordering of materials and mobilization of trades began in early May. This allowed our contractor Renokrew to install the jobsite trailer in June and actively begin work on the project. Fencing and hoarding has been set up to allow the work to proceed over the coming year while worship and ministry activities continue.

Throughout the summer, Renokrew has been preparing the site for the new addition. The first step was demolition of the existing garage, and all interiors in the rectory and offices. As some evidence of past leaks was found, all drywall and insulation has been removed to allow a new enclosure for these areas.

Following demolition, a new electrical transformer and connection was installed which will allow for the expansion of the building and the new heating and cooling equipment.

Once the site was clear, it was possible to begin construction of the addition. As the addition is located adjacent to the existing church, shoring had to be installed to hold up the church while the addition is built. Shoring beams and underpinning were installed around the church. Once the existing church was stabilized, new footings were poured.

In the coming weeks, foundation walls will be going up. All of the steel structure, cladding, and windows have been ordered. The summer has been a busy time preparing the site, and as we move into the fall we expect the framework for the new addition to take shape.

To date we have been operating within the approved budgets from the Archdiocese and are working towards completion in the late summer/early fall of 2025.
