PLENARY INDULGENCES DURING THE JUBILLE YEAR



The Holy See issued a decree outlining the many ways that Catholics can obtain a plenary indulgence during the 2025 Jubilee Year. Below you will find a brief summary of the essential aspects of obtaining plenary indulgences during the Jubilee Year. What is an Indulgence?

A plenary indulgence is a grace granted by the Catholic Church through the merits of Jesus Christ to remove the temporal punishment due to sin and while the Sacrament of Reconciliation restores grace, the effects of sin remain. The indulgence applies to sins already forgiven and a plenary indulgence cleanses the soul as if the person had just been baptized. Plenary indulgences obtained during the Jubilee Year can also be applied to souls in purgatory with the possibility of obtaining two plenary indulgences for the deceased in one day.

The Jubilee Indulgence is a plenary indulgence specifically intended for the faithful during a Jubilee Year, which occurs every 25 years. It allows individuals to seek full mercy for themselves or for the souls in Purgatory, highlighting the boundless nature of God's mercy.

Here are some of the many ways one can obtain indulgences during the 2025 Jubilee Year:

How is the Jubilee Indulgence obtained? To obtain the Jubilee Indulgence, one must be truly repentant, free from attachment to sin, and perform a prescribed act. This includes going to Confession, receiving Holy Communion, and praying for the Pope's intentions. The indulgence can also be applied to the souls in Purgatory.

There are several ways to obtain plenary indulgences:

1. THROUGH PILGRIMAGES.

At **any** designated Jubilee Pilgrimage site, participants should engage in Holy Mass (including the Profession of Faith), the Liturgy of the Hours, the Way of the Cross and other devotional practices. When you arrive at any designated site, you should spend a suitable amount of time in Eucharistic Adoration and conclude with the Lord's Prayer and the Profession of Faith and prayers to Mary. The Lord's Prayer and the Profession of Faith are both necessary to obtain the indulgence.

2. THROUGH PIOUS VISITS TO SACRED PLACES.

There are several churches designated as Jubilee Pilgrimage Sites in the Archdiocese of Toronto: Key sites include St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica and various parishes across each region including St Barnabas in Scarborough and St Gregory the Great in Oshawa in the East as well as Martyrs' Shrine in Midland.

Individuals who cannot physically attend a pilgrimage, including the elderly & the sick, can still receive the Jubilee Indulgence by uniting spiritually with the faithful through prayer and participation in the liturgy via media.

3. THROUGH ACTS OF MERCY AND PENANCE.

Acts of Mercy: Engaging in spiritual and corporal works of mercy, by spending time with those in need - the sick, prisoners, lonely elderly, the disabled essentially "making a pilgrimage to Christ present in them" can also lead to obtaining the indulgence.

Specifications for penance: Penance can include rediscovering the penitential nature of Fridays, abstaining from distractions, donating to the poor, and dedicating time to community service. In a spirit of penance, give up "futile distractions" (real or online) and "superfluous consumption" (through fasting, abstinence or almsgiving) for at least one day.
