

BUILDING EXPANSION PROGRESS REPORT

The Construction Committee is excited to provide us with an update on the renovation project...

Progress has been made to the exterior with the installation of roof shingles on the Rectory and the transition between the Church and the Atrium roof has also been completed. The Atrium roof deck has been waterproofed and drains have also been installed along with the roof mounted furnace. We're getting closer to the brick installation with the additional of the spray foam insulation to the exterior walls.

The interior space of the Rectory and the Atrium has had all structural elements completed, and room dividers/partition walls are 80 % in place. Rough-ins for electrical, plumbing, heating & cooling ductwork and sprinkler systems have been partially completed. Steel stairs have been partially installed in the east entrance of the Atrium. Widened door opening from the Church at the south east corner of the Nave to the Atrium has been completed with boarding still in place for finishing works including door installation in the coming weeks.

Looking ahead, brick work on the Rectory extension and the Atrium will begin this week. Work continues on the installation of utilities, and the interior finishes with insultation placement and drywall. Power shutdown by for the entire Church is scheduled for **May 5th to May 9th** to add the switching to the mechanical/electrical room in the basement of the Rectory. At the same time water system extension to the existing water feed in the Men's Washroom and the reconfiguration of the Women's Washroom entrance will be completed.

We want to thank you all for your continued support and patience during this exciting Building Expansion and Renovation Project.

As you are aware, we have used all of our funds raised to date and are now borrowing from the Archdiocese to cover expenses. If you have not had a chance yet to make your pledge, please pick up a pledge form at the back of the church.
