### **BUILDING EXPANSION PROGRESS REPORT**

As we welcome in the new school year, the beginnings of fall weather, our building project is in the final weeks towards completion. The Atrium is at the stage of hanging the baffles for the ceiling, commencing the porcelain tile flooring, and applying the final coats of paint. The south Narthex drywall is in place on the walls and ceiling with painting and flooring to be completed in the next several weeks. The offices are painted, the suspended ceiling rails are in place as is the light panels and some of the doors. The meeting rooms, lounge and storage lockers in the lower level have had the suspended ceiling rails installed where applicable and some light fixtures with flooring to commence in the next week. The remaining windows and doors are being installed in the rectory and ready for flooring. The millwork for the Café and the Residence is on site and ready to be installed after the flooring has been completed.

Exterior to the building expansion in the south parking area, the concrete sidewalk and curbs have been poured and the gravel grading and paving have been completed last week. Final grading of the rear yard, fence restoration and sodding are to be completed once the sprinkler system has been tested and final connection made at the Ribblesdale streetline. Thankfully the domestic water supply was connected and functioning to the new service and the existing service abandoned. Thank you to everyone for your patience during the disruptions to service.
