

Dear friends,

Merry Christmas. As we arrive at this holy day, I want to thank you for walking through Advent with such openness and hope. Over the past four weeks, we reflected on a simple theme: light in the darkness. Each Sunday reminded us that God's light doesn't wait for life to be perfect. It shows up in ordinary places, often quietly, and invites us to trust that grace is already at work.

We lit the first candle to remember that even a small light can change a room. The second candle reminded us that God's peace doesn't remove every hardship, but steadies us so we can keep going. The third candle taught us that joy grows when it's shared, even in tough seasons. And the fourth candle brought us back to love, the light that holds all the others together.

They're signs of the life God is stirring in our community and the hope we share for the future.


