PASTORS' MESSAGE

What the Three Kings Teach Us for the New Year

On Epiphany, we remember the three kings who followed a star into the unknown. They did not have all the answers. They only had a sign, a question in their hearts, and the courage to begin.

They teach us first to seek. The kings were paying attention. In a noisy world, they noticed the star and chose to follow it. As a new year begins, Epiphany invites us to look up again. To ask what truly matters and to move toward it, even when the path is not clear.

They also teach us perseverance. The journey was long and uncomfortable. Still, they kept going. The new year will bring challenges we did not plan. Like the kings, we are reminded that faith and hope grow through steady steps, not quick answers.

When they arrived, they offered gifts. Gold, frankincense, and myrrh were costly and meaningful. This teaches us to bring our best. Not just what is easy or leftover, but our time, kindness, and love. What we offer this year can bless others more than we realize.

Finally, the kings listened. Warned in a dream, they went home by a different way. Epiphany reminds us that meeting Christ changes us. The new year may call us to choose a different path, let go of old habits, or walk home wiser than before.

As we begin this year, may we seek with hope, travel with trust, give generously, and stay open to being changed. Like the three kings, may we follow the light we are given and let it lead us forward.


MEETING TO PLAN MILLIONS OF MONICAS - JAN 5TH
