MEMORIAL & RECOGNITION WALL

As we celebrate the completion of our construction project, we give thanks for the generosity and love that made it possible. Two meaningful spaces are being created in the new south Narthex, across from the Parish Office.

The Memorial Wall will be a sacred place to honour loved ones who now rest in Christ's peace. Marble engravable plaques (4 × 6 inches) may include a name with years (e.g., John Smith 1943–2023) or a family name (e.g., The Smith Family). Each plaque is \$300 and available on a first-come, first-served basis, as space is limited. The wall will feature a beautiful backlit wooden cross as a focal point of prayer and remembrance. Beside it, the **Recognition Wall** will recognize cumulative gifts of \$3,000 or more. Due to the number of donors, this threshold helps us use the limited space responsibly. We are mindful that not everyone can give at this level and sincerely apologize if anyone feels overlooked. This project was built on the sacrifice of our entire parish community - like the widow's mite, each gift reflects love and devotion, not monetary value. The wall honours foundational gifts while we remain deeply grateful for every contribution. HOLY FAMILY BUILDING EXPANSION & RENOVATION UPDATE

Our building project is nearing completion. Most components have been finished, and any remaining exterior work that could not be completed due to weather will be addressed by Renokrew (General Contractor) in the spring. A Building Operations and Maintenance Committee has been formed to oversee the new facilities. Qualified professionals have been engaged to implement the Fire Plan and provide annual sprinkler system certification.

Some challenges remain. The elevator requires repairs and recertification by TSSA, which has been complex due to its age and sourcing replacement parts. We are working closely with architect Larkin, Renokrew, and the elevator subcontractor to resolve this. The new fire doors also require ongoing adjustments to ensure proper function, and solutions are being investigated.

We continue organizing internal storage and emptying the two sea containers in the parking lot, with the goal of removing them by spring. As we settle into the new space, we may experience minor adjustments. We are supported by a one-year warranty from the General Contractor during this transition. We remain deeply grateful for your continued support throughout this important project.
